### 2. AMBLESIDE RESILIENCE

Andy Caple addressed Council on the work he had done to date preparing a plan for resilience in the event of a major disaster in Ambleside. 70 to 80 volunteers are now in place with roads and areas of responsibility identified. There is a need for an overall coordinator and also area coordinators so that the telephone cascade system works effectively. There will also be a funding requirement to implement the scheme. Members asked various questions and the Chairman thanked him for his attendance.

### 3. OLD KELSICK GRAMMAR SCHOOL

David Williams addressed Council on the work to date by his company, Impact, at the old Kelsick Grammar School. He gave a slide presentation on proposals for the improvement and extensions that will be the subject of a planning application probably in April 2018. His company work with blue chip companies throughout the world giving leadership training, work inspiration and education that includes underprivileged children/young people. Impact Aid also supports local charities and this year they are supporting Jigsaw ,the children's cancer charity, run from Eden Valley Hospice.

Members asked various questions and the Chairman thanked him for his presentation.  
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The Chairman Adjourned the Meeting. One person spoke on issues at Greenbank/Castlefield including the play areas where a LIPS (locally important projects) application has been made. Cllrs Dixon and Hughes addressed Members on the possibility of improving Ambleside Market. Cllr Dixon is the portfolio holder at SLDC for Community, Health and Wellbeing and Localism. They wish to work in partnership with local people.. Jane Renouf said that the Library reopens on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January. There were no other representations The Meeting was Reconvened
